

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C245 Anchor Street from its junction with C397 Culleys Pit Road to its junction with C397 High Street in the PARISH OF TUNSTEAD because of BT pole testing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 6th December 2021 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: Anchor Street, Sloley Road, B1150 North Walsham Road, Tunstead Road, Market Street, Tunstead Road, B1354 Horning Road West, A1151 Stalham Road/Norwich Road, A149 Yarmouth Road, Union Road, Anchor Street (Barton Turf, Scottow, Smallburgh, Hoveton, Sloley, Tunstead, Ashmanhaugh, Neatishead).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

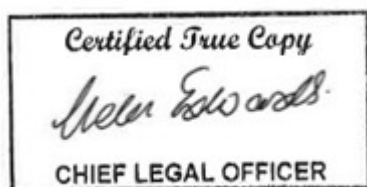
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
