

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6246) affecting the C245 Anchor Street from 80m west of its junction with C397 Culleys Pit Road for 50m westwards in the PARISH OF TUNSTEAD to facilitate new water main works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 14th to 16th March 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Anchor Street, Sloley Road, B1150 North Walsham Road, Tunstead Road, Market Street, Tunstead Road, Stone Lane, Church Road, Culleys Pit Road, Anchor Street (Scottow, Hoveton, Sloley, Tunstead, Ashmanhaugh).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

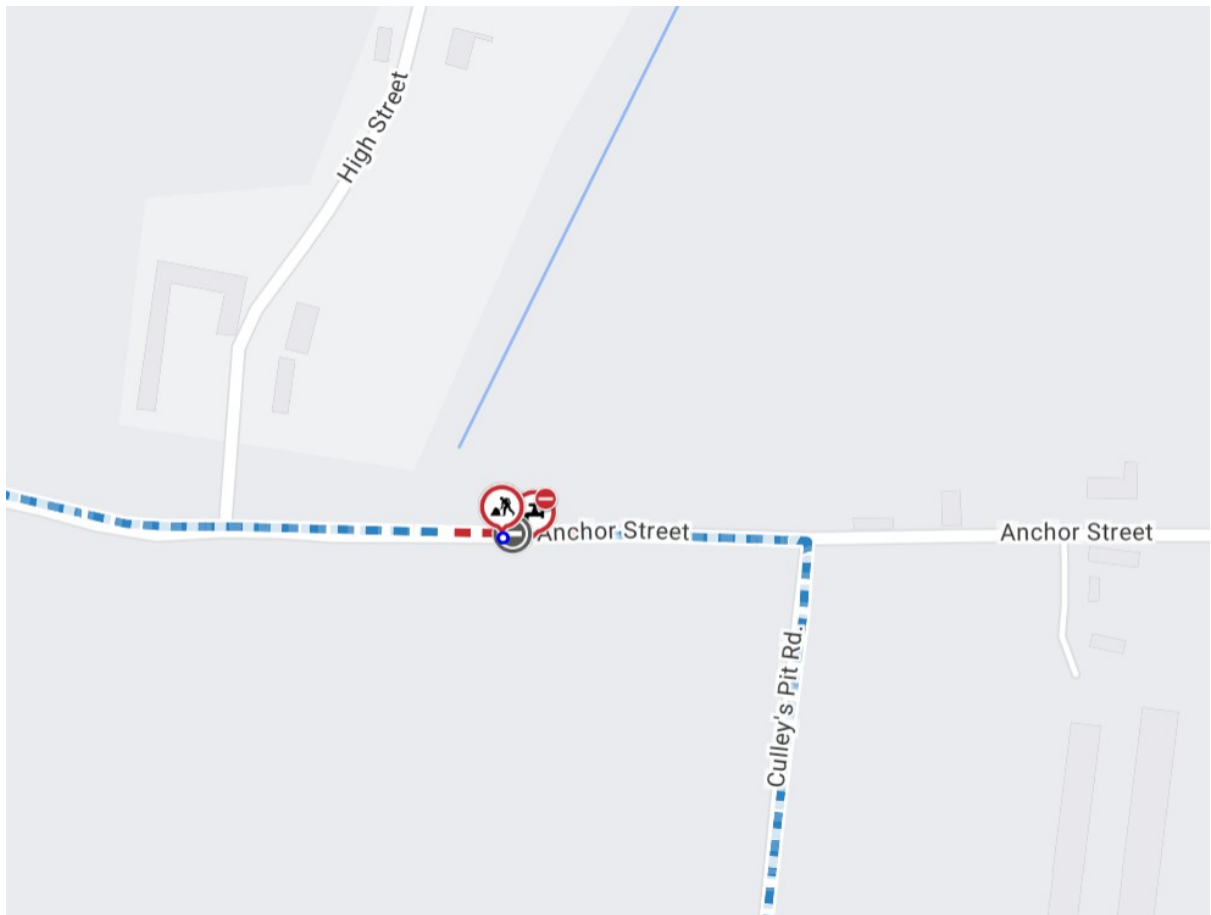
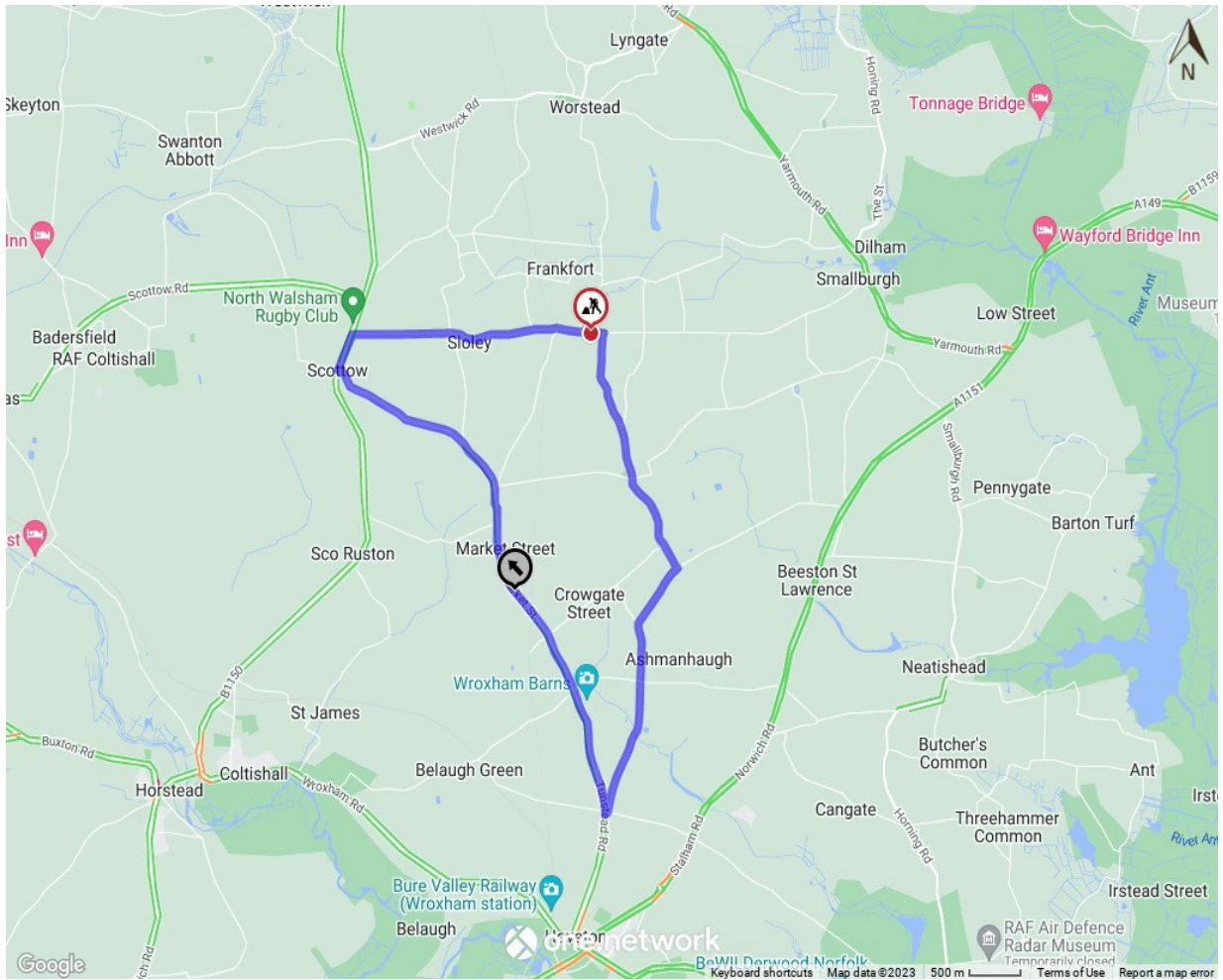
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
