

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7126) affecting the U19067 Belaugh Lane from 190m southwest of its junction with Tunstead Road for 70m south-westwards in the PARISH OF TUNSTEAD to facilitate level crossing renewal works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 00:30 and 10:00 from 16<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and between 00:30 and 10:00 from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> September 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 4 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Belaugh Lane, Tunstead Road, Market Street, Tunstead Road, B1150 North Walsham Road/Church Street/North Walsham Road/Station Road/High Street, B1354 Church Street/Wroxham Road, Belaugh Green Lane, Belaugh Road (Coltishall, Sloley, Tunstead, Belaugh, Hoveton, Scottow.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
