NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7926) affecting the Shop Lane from its junction with Anchor Street to its junction with Mill Lane in the PARISH OF TUNSTEAD to facilitate works to repair structural damage under road caused by badger tunnels.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 21st March 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 11th April to 31st July 2024 (previously 21st March to 10th April 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 112 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Mill Lane, Mill Road, Anchor Street

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
